### **The Top Ten Arguments**

- 1. The scriptures that condemn homosexuality have actually been mistranslated.**
- 2. The Bible verses that seem to prohibit homosexuality have been taken out of context.**
- 3. Jesus said nothing about homosexuality, so he did not condemn it.**
- 4. “We are in a loving, monogamous relationship. That can’t be wrong!”**

- 8. In Romans 1, Paul is not describing true homosexuals, rather he is referring to heterosexuals who “exchanged natural relations”, which would be sinful.**
- 9. Leviticus stipulates many things people were forbidden to do like not eat shell fish or wear clothing made with certain fabrics. Christians do not expect people to follow those commandments today, so why do we think that the scriptures on homosexuality are any different?**
